CHEM 107– Fundamentals of Chemistry	MATH 117, 118, 124, 141, 155 or 160 <u>or</u> concurrent registration in Math 118, 124, 141, 155 or 160
CHEM 108– Fundamentals of Chemistry Lab	CHEM 107 <u>or</u> Concurrent Registration
CHEM 111 – General Chemistry I	MATH 118, 124, 141, 155 or 160 <u>or</u> concurrent registration in Math 124,141, 155 or 160
CHEM 112 – General Chemistry I Lab	CHEM 111/117 <u>or</u> Concurrent Registration
CHEM 113 – General Chemistry II	CHEM 107, 111 or 117 <b>and</b> Math 124, 141, 155 or 160 <u>or</u> concurrent Registration in MATH 141, 155 or 160
CHEM 114 – General Chemistry II Lab	CHEM 113 <u>or</u> Concurrent Registration

***All prerequisites for chemistry classes will be enforced. Students who are currently registered in an appropriate equivalent math course or reasonably anticipate receiving AP or IB math credit can have a seat (class/recitation/lab) reserved for them through Lisa Dysleski in the Chemistry department. Students will not be allowed to register for a chemistry class without proof of successful completion of the appropriate prerequisite or CSU math placement score.***
